The Affiant, Officer S. Mitchell , being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, James Clifford Blaney , committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:

On September 21, 2024, at 2041 hours, Officer Underwood and Officer Mitchell responded to _____ in reference to a burglary. Multiple officers responded emergent to this address due to the reporting party, Sylveus Exile, advising their neighbor came into their garage with a firearm. The garage is connected to the residence.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with _____ and one of the victims, _____ and a witness, _____ who is _____ cousin and girlfriend to _____ All of them reside at _____ with _____ and _____ spoke primarily Haitian Creole. _____ assisted officers with translating. _____ advised the suspect was a white male, 30s-40s, wearing a black t-shirt, shorts and resided at 2113 Spring Meadow Circle. Officer Fisher, Officer Mefford, Officer Hogan and Officer Householder went to 2113 Spring Meadow Circle and made contact with James Blaney and his wife, Melissa Sullivan. Officer Mitchell walked with _____ to Mr. Blaney's residence where _____ positively identified Mr. Blaney as being the person who pointed a firearm at him and the three children. Mr. Blaney was detained at 2059 hours. Officer Fisher read him his Miranda Rights at 2059 hours.

Officers asked Mr. Blaney if he wanted to speak with officers about the incident after the Miranda was read. Mr. Blaney did not want to speak with officers and denied ever being in the victim's garage. Ms. Sullivan advised Mr. Blaney had been home and she hadn't seen him leave the house. Officers could smell a strong odor of alcoholic beverages coming from Mr. Blaney and Ms. Sullivan. Officers did not locate a firearm on Mr. Blaney but he does have a concealed handgun license.

_____ advised he was in the garage with _____ is the mother to _____ does not reside at this residence and is only a friend of the family. While the children were playing, _____ witnessed Mr. Blaney come into the garage and point a black firearm at him, (_____ . Mr. Blaney yelled at everyone to, "Shut up" and "Fuck you." Ms. Joseph advised she was inside the residence, opened the door to the garage and witnessed Mr. Blaney yelling "Shut up" and "Fuck you" while pointing a firearm at _____ and all the juvenile victims. She advised she was scared and attempted to close the garage door. When doing so, Mr. Blaney had to quickly bend over to run out of the garage due to the door closing. All individuals ran inside the residence and yelled for _____ to call the police.

_____ advised they did not want Mr. Blaney to be charged in fear that there will be retaliation in the future. _____ advised the children are not allowed to play outside, only in the garage or house due to fears of someone harming them.

Mr. Blaney was taken into custody and charged with three counts of aggravated burglary and one count of aggravated menacing. He was transported and booked into the Clark County Jail. Mr. Blaney will have court on Monday, September 23, 2024, at 1030 hours.


