

# Law Enforcement Arrest Report Probable Cause Affidavit

The Affiant, Detective J. Massie, being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Haley L. Daniels, committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:

On Friday October 4, 2024 at approximately 0123 hrs the victim, was shot multiple times about the chest and body following an argument between he and the defendant. The defendant, Shaylynn J. Ackerman and the victim, along with witnesses Sausha D. Threats and Justin M. Lanum were at witness Threats apartment to celebrate Threats' birthday. The four had been consuming alcohol and an argument began between the defendant and the victim. Ackerman contacted associates of hers after the victim began making threats to have the apartment shot up. Ackerman contacted friends who would later come to the area of Cole Manor. The victim was still in the area, near the complex when four unknown suspects exited a vehicle and shot him multiple times before fleeing in that vehicle. The victim retreated to the entrance of Cole Manor where he was met by witnesses Threats and Lanum. SPD and SFRD responded, secured the scene and the victim was transported to Springfield Regional. After being treated at SRMC he was taken to Miami Valley Hospital. At the time of this report the victim was under going surgery at MVH.

Detective Jordan responded to the scene and after speaking with witnesses, including the Shaylynn Ackerman (defendant#1), Ackerman was transported to police hq's for further questioning. An extraction of her cell phone discovered deleted messages between she and one of the potential suspect's girlfriend, Haley Daniels. The messages indicated that the Ackerman had communicated with Daniels and the suspects and was complicit in getting the suspects to the area to shoot the victim.

Based upon these facts defendant Ackerman is charged with Attempted Aggravated Murder and Complicity to Felonious Assault. Her DNA was collected and she was placed in jail.

Marques Thomas and Haley Daniels were identified by Ackerman as the other parties she communicated with prior to the shooting. Detectives utilized law enforcement databases that identified Thomas' address as 1946 Primm Dr. Apt L. Haley Daniels was the listed resident at 1946 Primm Dr. Apt L on the lease agreement at Ronez Manor corroborating the identification by Ackerman.

Detectives spoke with a witness that stated Marques Thomas, Haley Daniels and "Jerry" (Jeremiah Roberts) were at an apartment in Ronez scrubbing their hands to destroy gunshot residue evidence. Haley Daniels told the witness about Marques Thomas and Jeremiah Roberts was involved in the shooting of the victim. Ronez Manor staff gave Detective Massie information that Marques Thomas and Haley Daniels were going between 1946 Primm Dr. Apt L and 1934 Primm Dr. Apt G. Detectives then began surveillance in Ronez at that time. Based on the totality of information and circumstances at that time in the investigation, Detectives had probable cause to arrest Haley Daniels and Marques Thomas. Detectives also believed that evidence from the shooting was concealed inside both addresses based on information received at that time in the investigation. Detectives and Officers approached both listed addresses at which time Marques Thomas fled on foot from the rear of 1946

Primm Dr. Apt L. He was told to stop multiple times by officers giving chase to him and he failed to stop. Officers that were surrounding 1934 Primm Dr. gave chase to Mr. Thomas on foot where he gave up and was taken into custody. Mr. Thomas then advised officers he was possessing a firearm in the backpack he was wearing. Thomas was mirandized after he volunteered this statement. Thomas then admitted to being with the group responsible for shooting the victim but claimed he did not shoot. He was transported to SPD HQ. A search incident to arrest revealed the firearm was a stolen Taurus G3C 9mm handgun.

Detective Lish spoke with the victim at Miami Valley Hospital. The victim positively identified Marques Thomas as a suspect that shot him. He also identified Jeremiah Roberts as a suspect that approached him with Marques Thomas but doesn't recall if he had a gun.

Marques Thomas ultimately admitted to shooting the victim after denying this multiple times. He stated the victim was in a drunken state and not a threat to anyone and he changed his story to "self defense" after he knew he had been identified as the shooter.

Haley Daniels was also transported to Police HQ where she was mirandized. She stated Shaylynn and her were on a video call when she observed Logan grab at Shaylynn's arm. Haley stated she did not agree with that and then Shaylynn was asking for a ride from the apartment. Haley told Shaylnn they would need to wait for a ride. Haley described arriving with multiple people to include Jeremiah Roberts and Marques Thomas. While at the apartment returned on foot and was approached by Marques and Jeremiah. Initially Haley stated Jeremiah shot first and that Marques allegedly shot into the ground. She later changed her story when confronted with the identification of Marques being the only shooter. She stated Marques pulled his gun first and activated the beam on his gun and it was pointed at the ground. She stated once that occurred she began walking to the car when shots began. Haley stated they all returned to her apartment where Jeremiah and Marques discussed the shooting and took count of the bullets they had fired.

Based upon these facts Marques Thomas was charged with attempted aggravated murder, felonious assault, having weapons while under disability, carrying concealed weapons, receiving stolen property and obstructing official business. Haley Daniels was charged with attempted aggravated murder and complicity to felonious assault. Daniels and Thomas were placed in the Clark County Jail awaiting arraignment.
