The Affiant, Deputy Anthony Reynolds , being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Jamesia Marie Ruffin , committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:

BWCR / ICCR

On December 30th, 2024, Deputies were dispatched to 8 Walnut St., in the Village of South Charleston, Township of Madison, County of Clark, State of Ohio, in reference to a burglary.

Upon arrival, Deputies met with the RP, _____ who advised that a skinny black female wearing a red hat had walked in her front door and attempted to walk to the kitchen. _____ advised that she was able to escort the female out of her house and onto the porch, where she prompted her daughter to call 911. _____ advised that the female walked off in an unknown direction. _____ completed a witness statement as Deputies canvased the area for the female who was thought to be on foot in the area.

During the search of the area, Deputies located the female, Identified as Jamesia Ruffin, walking on the side walk in the intersection of E. Jamestown St and N. Chillicothe St. Parked in the intersection, was a blue Hummer H3, bearing Ohio registration #PNK6552. While speaking with Deputies, Jamesia stated that she had walked into the wrong house and that she was driving the Hummer. When asked, Jamesia advised that she did not know who the truck belonged to, further stating that god had guided her to the truck and it had the keys in it. At this time, Jamesia was detained and read miranda. Jamesia advised that she did not understand her miranda rights, therefore they were readvised and explained, which she advised she understood and elected to envoke her rights to speak with Deputies.


During the course of the investigation, the owner of the Hummer, _____, was found to reside at _____, directly next-door to 8 Walnut. Deputies conducted a door knock and spoke with _____ who advised that no one should have the vehicle. _____ rode with Deputies back to the scene to confirm that the vehicle was his. Photos of the vehicle were collected on scene and the vehicle was released back to _____.


