**The Affiant, Officer Collin Peterson , being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Daniel Allen Bussard , committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:**

On February 20, 2024 at 1000hrs Officers Peterson, Warnock, Holbrook, Hammann, Det. Devore, and Det. Emory were dispatched to \_\_\_\_\_ in reference to a a red Pontiac Sunfire bearing license plate KGQ6515. Det. Emory and Devore had seen the call come out and advised officers that they were en route as well. They also advised they were familiar with the vehicle due to recent thefts and that Daniel Bussard had been driving it and had an active Capias.

When arriving on scene Officer Peterson, Det. Emory, and Det. Devore went to the rear of the business where the vehicle was parked. The caller / owner, \_\_\_\_\_ was also at the rear. He advised officers that he had not seen anyone come outside but there were footprints in the snow leading up to an opening. He did advise he was the owner of the building, for which he is currently attempting to renovate, and the name of the business is \_\_\_\_\_. Sgt. Osbourne had also arrived on scene and stood by out front to assist with surrounding the building.

Det. Emory, Devore, and Off. Peterson made entry into a side door that was open where the footprints lead up to. When making entry Det. Emory yelled inside identifying officers and telling anyone to come out. Officers did not hear anything so entry was made. Det. Emory went left into the room while Det. Devore and Off. Peterson went right. Shortly after making entry Daniel Bussard was located inside a large metal container by Det. Emory. He gave him commands to come out. Det. Devore moved up behind Det. Emory while Officer Peterson went around the far side. Once out of the container he took off running around the side where Officer Peterson was. He ran directly into Officer Peterson who had his firearm in his hand. Mr. Bussard had to be tackled to the ground where he was taken into custody without further incident.

When speaking with \_\_\_\_\_ he advised the door that the prints in the snow had lead up to had been broken down three days prior for which he did not fix at that time. Mr. Bussard had a red book bag just inside the door next to the fire that he had built. Next to the bag was several pieces of scrap metal that had been piled up. Mr. Bussard is known by Det. Emory to frequent the scrap yard to scrap metal. Det. Emory asked for consent to search the vehicle that was parked at the rear of the business but Mr. Bussard denied. The vehicle was towed to Maines. Photos of the scene were taken by Det. Emory.

Mr. Bussard was charged with Breaking and Entering, Obstructing Official Business, and Resisting Arrest. He was served his Capias for Theft. He was placed in the Clark County Jail.


