**The Affiant, Officer Amanda Rosales , being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Robert E McClurg Jr , committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:**

On 03/11/25 at 0013 hrs, 411E (Officer Oates), witnessed a vehicle turn into National Tire and Battery, circle the building, and stop and turn off its lights.

Officer Oates approached the vehicle, a 2008 Chevrolet Impala, and found it to be occupied by a male and a female, with the vehicle pulled up to the tire disposal area. The vehicle did have multiple tires in the vehicle. When asked what they were doing at the business, the male stated that they were eating food, and were collecting tires. The male stated that they had permission to collect the old tires from the business. He stated that the tires in the vehicle came from Midas on N Bechtle Ave. Officer Oates asked the male for his name and social security number. The male gave the name of Todd Cochran and a social ending in 3628. Officer Oates also ran the plate on the vehicle JFN 5529. The social that the male gave did not come back to the name, and the plate did not come back to the vehicle that it was on. At that time, the male was asked to exit the vehicle. The license plate came back to a Black Acura. After asking the male again, the male then gave his correct name, Robert McClurg, and birth date. At that time, the male was detained. The female at that time was asked to step out of the vehicle, and she was placed in front of Cruiser 56. Sgt. Slusser then attempted to locate the male's driver's license in the vehicle. The female was asked to identify herself, and she stated that she was Katelyn Rector. Both Mr. McClurg and Ms. Rector were found to be clear of warrants and to have suspended driver's licenses.

Due to Mr. McClurg giving false information, Officer Oates then requested permission to search the vehicle and Mr. McClurg gave verbal consent to search the vehicle. During the search, Officer Oates did find a Red Coleman Cooler on the passenger side of the vehicle on the floorboard where the female was sitting, along with a cigarette pack that had an unused charboy in it as well. At that time, Ms. Rector was detained. Sgt. Slusser at that time requested a female officer to come to the scene to assist in searching the female. Officer Oates took the cooler out and put it on the trunk of the vehicle. During the search of the cooler, Officer Oates located multiple pill bottles belonging to a Robert Rainwater and a Cassandra White. Mr. McClurg stated that Mr. Rainwater lived with him and that they used the cooler together when they are working. Officer Rosales arrived on scene and found drug paraphernalia that was recently used in the top left pocket of the female, a clear bulbous pipe. At that time the female was placed in custody and placed in Cruiser 30. Officer Oates continued to search the cooler and found nothing else. During the search of the pill bottles, Officer Oates found pills that were not what was labeled on the bottle as well as a small white crystal like substance. Mr. McClurg denied ownership, and at that time he was placed in custody and placed in Cruiser 56. Officers also found multiple pink six-sided pills with an 8 stamped on one side. After looking the pills up on drugs.com, they were found to be Suboxone. The remainder of the pill bottles were taken and submitted into property to be tested.

Officer Rosales read Ms. Rector her Miranda Rights at 0110, and Ms. Rector agreed to answer questions. She stated that they were supposed to go to McDonald's to get food, in which they did. She was unaware that they were going to go to National Tire and Battery. They pulled up the tire disposal area, stating that the gates were already open. She stated that Mr. McClurg told her that he was advised that the tires were junk, and that he was allowed to take them. In regards to the drugs, she was unaware of anything in the cooler. She advised that she knew who Robert Rainwater was because that is Mr. McClurg's roommate, and that she is unaware who Cassandra White is.

Mr. McClurg was read his Miranda Rights at 0111, and he refused to answer any questions pertaining to the incident. He stated that the tires were from Midas on N Bechtle Ave, and that he did not know where the drugs came from. He stated that the pills owned by Robert Rainwater were his roommates.

Officer Oates at that time requested a police tow, and was granted one by Sgt. [redacted]. Maine's Towing took possession of the vehicle. Officer Rosales transported Katelyn Rector to Clark County Jail and was booked for one count of Theft, two counts of drug paraphernalia, and one count of possession of drugs. Officer Oates transported Robert McClurg to Clark County Jail and was booked for one count theft, one count of drug paraphernalia, one count of possession of drugs, and one count of failure to identify. Both were given a court date of 03/11/25 at 1030. Possession of drug charges are pending lab results.
