STATEMENT OF FACTS

At approximately 1:15 AM on Sunday, March 16, 2025 (St. Patrick's weekend), while conducting routine patrol in the area of S. Limestone and Liberty Ave in the City of Springfield, I observed a southbound vehicle approaching while displaying bright headlights. The vehicle appeared to be traveling above the posted 35 miles per hour speed limit. Using front-moving radar, I confirmed the vehicle's speed at 51 miles per hour. The radar tone was clear, loud, and trailed off as the vehicle passed, indicating a valid speed reading.

I initiated a traffic stop for the observed speeding violation and the failure to dim headlights when approaching oncoming traffic. Upon activating my emergency lights, the driver slowed and moved to the right but struck the right curb. The driver was slow to bring the vehicle to a complete stop, eventually stopped in the middle of the intersection, which obstructed traffic. These observations; failing to maintain proper lane position and stopping inappropriately, are consistent with indicators of possible impairment, as per my training in DWI detection from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA).

I approached the driver's window and immediately detected the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the interior of the vehicle. The driver, later identified as Edzaire Desir, provided his Ohio driver's license, and I observed that his eyes were red and glassy. I inquired about his alcohol consumption, at which point he showed me a can of automotive parts cleaner in the cup holder. Mr. Desir indicated that he did not speak English, prompting me to ask him to exit the vehicle so that I could utilize a telephone translation service.

While seated in the back of my patrol vehicle, I continued to detect a strong odor of alcohol emanating from Mr. Desir. I used a telephone translation service to facilitate communication and again asked the driver about his alcohol consumption. Mr. Desir stated that he had consumed one alcoholic drink.

I proceeded to conduct the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) test. Mr. Desir confirmed that he was not wearing contact lenses. Upon examining his pupils, I observed they were equal in size and tracked normally. However, he did not follow the instructions for the test and failed to follow the stimulus with his eyes. When his eyes did move, nystagmus (the involuntary jerking of the eyes) was present, which is consistent with impairment due to alcohol consumption, as outlined in the NHTSA SFST Manual.

I then asked Mr. Desir to submit to a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), to which he agreed. However, when instructed to provide a breath sample, Mr. Desir appeared to blow into the straw, but no air was emitted from the end of the straw, indicating that he failed to provide a valid sample.

Based on the behaviors I observed I determined Edzaire Desir was under the influence of alcohol. He was placed under arrest and advised of his Miranda rights. I took Mr. Desir to the Springfield Highway Patrol post and again used a translation service to read the test and refusal consequences (BMV2255).

I transported Mr. Desir to the Springfield Highway Patrol Post, where I utilized the telephone translation service to read him the consequences of refusing the breath test (BMV2255). Mr. Desir agreed to submit to a breath test but failed to provide a breath sample when instructed. As a result, he was issued a notice of suspension, and his Ohio driver's license was seized. Mr. Desir was issued a citation and ordered to appear in the Clark County Municipal court on Friday March 21, 2025 at 11:00 am.

IMMOBILIZATION OR FORFEITURE UPON OVI ARREST (R.C. 4511.195)

If you have previously been convicted of operating a motor vehicle under the influence, OVI (R.C. 4511.19 (A)), or similar municipal ordinance, the vehicle and its identification license plates may be seized. The vehicle may be towed and kept by the law enforcement agency or may be immobilized. The period of time for which the vehicle and license plates will be kept or immobilized may be at least until the initial appearance in court. At the initial appearance the court may order that the vehicle and license plates be returned or released to the vehicle owner until the disposition of the charge. If you are convicted of or plead guilty to OVI, the court may issue an order of immobilization of the vehicle and the impoundment of its license plates, or an order for the criminal forfeiture of the vehicle to the state. If you are not the vehicle owner you must immediately inform the owner that the vehicle and its license plates have been seized and that the owner may be able to obtain the return or release of the vehicle and plates at your initial appearance in court.

OFFENDERS ARRESTED FOR DRIVING UNDER SUSPENSION OR WRONGFUL ENTRUSTMENT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE (R.C. 4511.203).

If you are charged for driving under an OVI suspension, (R.C. 4510.14), or wrongful entrustment of a motor vehicle, (R.C. 4511.203), the vehicle and identification plates may be seized, and the vehicle may be towed and kept by the law enforcement agency. Any period of seizure will be at least until your initial appearance in court. At the initial appearance the court may order the vehicle returned to you or released to the vehicle owner. If you are convicted of driving under suspension, or of wrongful entrustment of a vehicle, the court may issue an order of immobilization of the vehicle and impoundment of its license plates. Upon a third conviction of wrongful entrustment of a vehicle (R.C. 4511.203), of driving under suspension (R.C. 4510.11), or a municipal ordinance similar to one of the above, the court, upon your conviction may order the forfeiture of the vehicle.
