



The Affiant, Deputy A. Bowers, being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Sammie Junior Ledford, committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:

On April 25, 2025 Myself, Deputy Arnold, and Deputy Likens were having lunch at Arrow Queen, located at 427 N. Main St. in the city oh New Carlisle Ohio, County of Clark. As we were finishing up with our lunch all of our attention was drawn to someone who was yelling at another person in front of the New Carlisle Bureau of Motor Vehicles, located at 430 N. Main St. As we all got up from the table we began to walk quickly towards the yelling subjects. As we neared the roadway Deputy Liken advised that the males were starting to physically fight one another in front of the business.

We all ran across the street to try and separate the subjects. Upon our arrival to the two subjects a male subject, who we already knew to be Sammy Ledford Junior, from a history of dealing with him in the past, was on top of another male subject and was punching him. Deputy Arnold was able to handcuff Mr. Ledford while Deputy Likens and I held his arms into a cuffing position, behind his back. Deputy Arnold and I were able to get Mr. Ledford removed from off top of the other male subject. Deputy Likens took the other male subject who was being calm and compliant and separated him away from Mr. Ledford. I moved my cruiser over to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, where deputy Arnold temporarily secured Mr. Ledford in the back of my cruiser.

I was able to locate one witness who was at the scene when the assault started, Mr. Douglas Hill. Mr. Hill did not wish to fill out a written official statement, but did give me a verbal statement on my body worn camera. I asked Mr. Hill what took place. He stated that Sammy Ledford came up behind the other male and tackled him and began hitting him. I was also able to meet with the owner of the Marathon Gas Station, located at 419 N. Main St. which sit across the street diagonally from the Bureau office, to see if his security cameras caught anything related to the assault. Mr. Milhelm looked at his camera footage and was able to find video of the assault as it took place prior to our arrival. In the video you can see the male subject who was later identified to be , walking just in front of the Bureau office on the sidewalk. You see Mr. Ledford run up behind and tackle him to the ground and begin punching him.

Deputy Arnold and Deputy Peterson also spoke with Allison Schuyler and Elizabeth Reed who reside in one of the apartment units directly above the Bureau office. Ms. Reed stated she heard yelling coming from outside and stated that she heard someone yelling over and over "he's going to kill me." Ms. Schuyler stated she was on her phone when she heard someone yelling over and over "he's going to kill me." She stated that she looked closer out her front window, which over looked the front of the Bureau office, and stated that a male in a gray shirt was on top of a man in a yellow shirt and had his arms pinned down behind him.

While was getting checked by medics on the squad I met and spoke with him and asked if he would like to fill out an official statement as well and he stated yes. stated that he was eating lunch inside the restaurant Studebakers located at 416 N. Main St. also in the city of

New Carlisle, next door the Bureau office. He stated that while he was inside he noticed a male subject in the back of the restaurant and stated the man winked his eye at him. He stated he gave a friendly head nod gesture to acknowledge the man. He stated the man kept staring at him the whole time he was eating in the restaurant. He stated when he finished his meal he left the restaurant, and walked towards his truck which he stated he parked in the far northeast corner of the parking lot. He stated he drove over to another business located on the back side of the Bureau building, as it is a multibusiness building. He stated he was speaking with one of his friends, and as he was finishing speaking with his friend, he stated he told him that the Bureau office looked like it was not busy, so he was going to leave and walk over to it to get his new license plate picked up. stated he turned the corner to start walking in out front of the Bureau office, and stated that is when he heard someone behind him yelling at him. He stated he started to turn him self around and that is when he observed the man, later identified to him as Sammy Ledford, charging at him, and knocking him down into the gravel next to the parking lot. I asked if he wanted to file a charge of assault against Mr. Ledford and he stated yes.

i took photographs of and his injuries at the scene. stated he only had minor injuries, but was sore. Mr. Ledford was seen by a medic while secured in the back of my cruiser. The medic stated that Mr. Ledford did have some redness to the side of his stomach, but other than that appeared to be perfectly fine. The medic stated that Mr. Ledford stated he did not want to be evaluated.

Mr. Ledford was charged with disorderly conduct, and assault. Deputy Liken called the jail and they stated they would keep Mr. Ledford on those charges. Mr. Ledford was given a copy of his affidavit charges and was transported by Deputy Arnold to the Clark County Jail, where he was booked in on those charges.
