The Affiant, Officer Fisher , being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Brady Chase Satterfield , committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:

On 9/26/25 at 1524 hours, Officers Fisher and Mefford were dispatch to _____ reference a suspicious person inside the building.

Officers were pulled out of roll call to respond, as the connected preschool at Saint Joseph's Catholic Church, was reporting the male was in the bathroom making statements about a gun. Per dispatch notes, the school entered a lock down and the parents waiting to pick up kids were made to wait. Prior to arriving on scene, staff called back in advising the male was gone. Officer met with staff members Cantus Chan and Breonna Anderson at the school.

Ms. Chan advised that the male entered behind a parent arriving to pick up their child at 1457 hours, following in directly behind where he then went towards a bathroom down the main hallway. Ms. Chan and Ms. Anderson did not recognize the male as a parent and immediately notified the rest of staff. Ms. Chan advised only several students remained at the school while waiting to get picked up, and they notified the parents to wait to pick up as the male was still inside the bathroom. While in the bathroom, staff reported hearing him either talking to himself or on a phone about not getting his benefits, or getting his cut of something. Ms. Anderson and another staff member who had already left, reported hearing the male mention something about getting his gun. No staff member reported every seeing a weapon, but given the circumstance and statements made, they remained on lock down until the male walked out of the building at 1512 hours. The school is locked by an electronic locking device that has to be unlocked by staff. It is intended to restrict the access to unauthorized personnel.

Ms. Anderson provided pictures of the male, seen wearing blue hospital attire, and multi-color bracelets. Several additional units responded to check the area for the male but no one could identify him from the pictures. At approximately 1620 hours, Officers Fisher and Mefford located the male at East St and Harrison St on a bike. Officers stopped the male and detained him at that time so he could be identified. The male was found to be Brady Satterfield out of Springfield. Mr. Satterfield was checked for weapons and provided that he had a knife in the plastic bag he was carrying. Mr. Satterfield was read his Miranda Warning and advised he wished to speak at that time.

Mr. Satterfield provided he had just recently been released from Haven Mental Health in Dayton which is why he was in scrubs. He claims he entered the building and collected a box of cereal at a free for taking table. Mr. Satterfield went to the restroom, claiming he never made any statements about having a weapon. Mr. Satterfield left the property and then went to a friend's house in the area of Willard Ave and Sheridan Ave where he has been staying. Mr. Satterfield got a bicycle and then came back to the area where Officers located him.

Due to the statements made by witnesses, the fact that school was placed on lock down, Officers placed Mr. Satterfield in custody at that time for Inducing Panic and Trespassing. At HQ, a fixed blade and tin foil wrapper containing an unknown substance were collected. The substance was submitted to BCI for chemical testing under receipt #38997.

DNA is on file.

Mr. Satterfield was booked in at the Clark County Jail for one count of inducing panic and one count of criminal trespass.
